

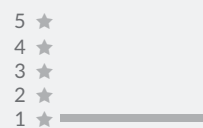

### Q1 What are some things you appreciate and some concerns you have about your school and/or Parkland School Division this year?

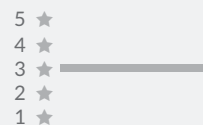

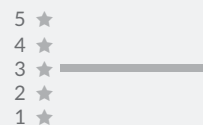
**Teachers in AAC do not aid students. Have emailed multiple times- no response.** Offered at distance learning but there is no help available unless you go in.

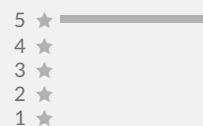
**If students can eat lunch in their classrooms, why can we not also eat with friends from a safe distance. Conversation could help this dismal view our Staff has of the school.**

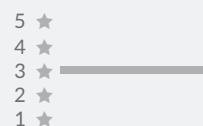
**I appreciate the hard work of all the staff!** They've done everything in their power to make life easier for the kids during all this chaos!

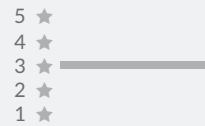
**There are not enough supports in the school , teachers can not handle the children with everything going on. More support is needed.** Kids mental health needs to be taken more serious.

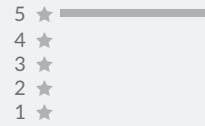

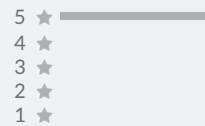
**Communication** I'm very grateful for the communication. Like everyone else, life is crazy and the reminders are helpful to help balance things!

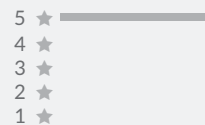

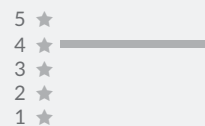

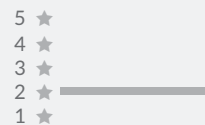
**I love that the school is available close to home in our small community.** We know the families our children go to school with which adds an element of connection and safety and brings the community together. Good for covid.

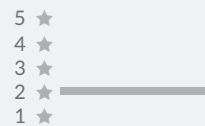
**Communication has been transparent and clear** I appreciate knowing what the school division is doing with regards to Covid precautions.

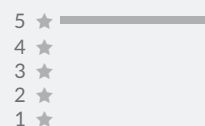

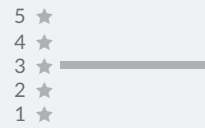

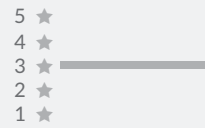
**Parents need more communication. Not having access to the school as we are all used too, leaves us in the dark and wondering what is going on. on**

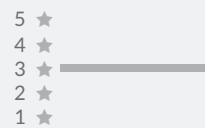

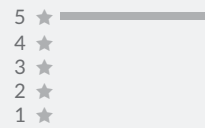

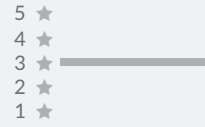
**Our school division has obviously put a tremendous amount of effort into being flexible to accommodate the needs of our children during this school yr Its necessary with the huge variety of needs each family has**

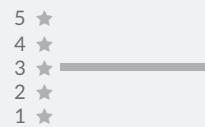
**Concerned about insufficient outdoor supervision during recess and lunch. This is important so our kids can feel safe, focus on learning, and not work about bullying.**

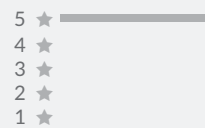
**Workload - more “new” things to learn and have to do during a year already “full” because of a Covid. Causes teachers stress and anxiety and many more hours of work.**

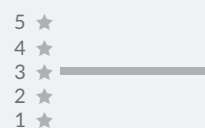

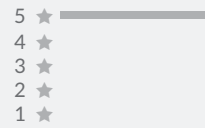
**Ability to highlight offerings of French Immersion For the families enrolled we need to ensure the information from CPF Parkland chapter is shared throughout the division.**

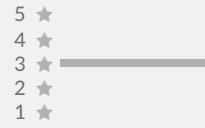
**Coping with COVID-19** My school has worked hard to make school "home" for our students amid all the challenges of COVID-19.

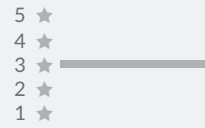
**Lack of resource for students who are not considered "exceptional."** Many behaviour students are not being identified by learning services as having needs. There is a lack of resources to support these kids.

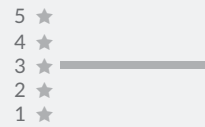

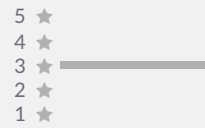
**Students need tech literacy, but also neat printing by hand** Overlooking messy printing disadvantages students later in life and may mean that learning disorders aren't diagnosed

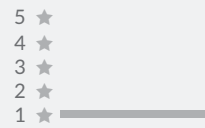
**MCHS needs the access road widened or another way in or out of the school** Bottle neck to get in or out

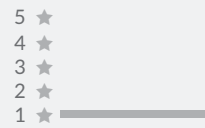
