- Costumes that include weapons, portray violence or that are gruesome or graphic in nature are not appropriate for the school day. Whole face masks are not allowed during the school day but students may wear them during the parade if they are appropriate
  - Part of creating a safe school community for ALL students on Halloween is to make sure racially, ethnically, culturally and gender identity based costumes are NOT part of our festivities because peoples' gender identity and their cultures are not costumes. We

invite families to reflect on the questions below prior to selecting a costume for school activities.

- Is the costume racially, ethnically or culturally based?
  - If the answer yes, it is probably going to make some children from different cultures or of different ethnicity feel unsafe
- Does your child belong to that group of people?
  - If the answer is no, then reflect on what it means to borrow someone's culture or race or identity for the day. It is not a costume but their everyday lives.
  - o Is the costume meant to be funny? Why is it funny?
    - If the costume is meant to be funny because it is making light of an ethnic group or racial group, or someone's gender identity, then it is only hurtful.
- If you are not sure about a costume then choose another one for school or dress in traditional Halloween colors or an object or your favorite animal. There are so many choices!
