- The division focus this year is to bring awareness to chronic absences and the risk of learning loss in school. (I.e: Two absences per month equates to a 10 percent loss in instruction and learning opportunities.)
- The Book Fair was a success. \$6000 in sales.
- Indigenous ways of knowing: Students were awarded a golden ticket and a free book from the book fair for demonstrating the Sacred Teaching of the Month- The Turtle: Truth.
- Numeracy: Tier three intervention (pull-out) for gr. 3-6 started this month.
- 5 new flag poles have been installed.
- I wish: Parent question- why isn't PowerSchool being updated regularly? Discussion: How can we provide meaningful feedback for grades k-3 in the gradebook?

7.0 Board Report

- French immersion is an area of concern. Results are low in comparison to the rest of the province.
- Div. office is discussing releasing the school calendar earlier in the year. A survey will circulate to offer parent input. Fall break will remain a five-day break going forward.


