Reporting Absences

To report an absence for your child, please email <u>forestgreen@psd.ca</u> or call and leave a message at the school office (780-963-7366). Please include the student's name, teacher (or grade), and reason for the absence in your message.

This year we will be working to increase our attendance rates at Forest Green. Did you know that 90% attendance rate means you're chronically absent? It's equivalent to missing one month of learning in a year. Absences reduce your child's chances of academic success and can negatively impact their mental well-being. Attend today, achieve tomorrow!

Parents play a crucial role in helping us improve attendance rates at Forest Green. You can support your child's regular attendance by establishing consistent morning routines, ensuring they get a good night's sleep, and scheduling appointments or vacations outside of school hours whenever possible. Encourage your child to view school as a priority and talk with them about the importance of being present every day. If your child is facing challenges that impact their attendance, please reach out to us so we can work together to find solutions. Your involvement is key to helping your child succeed! Drop-Off & Pick-UP

Please note the following important information regarding child safety and parking at Forest Green.

- 1. Bus Drop-Off is at 8:15 am
- 2. Students who are being driven or walking should plan to be here after 8:20, but before 8:30.
- 3. Supervision begins at 8:15 am, please do not drop your children off before this time as there are no adults outside to supervise.
- 4. Students stay outside in their zone when they arrive at school until the first bell.
- 5. Speed (30km/hour or less) Please ensure you are following the speed limit. Please remember, the speed limit is for optimal road conditions, our little cul-de-sac is often very icy, please adjust your speed accordingly.
- 6. If you are picking up or dropping off your child, and you see a bus behind you, please do not stop. Just make another loop so you are behind the bus. We need to get the buses in and out as quickly as possible.
- 7. Curbside Parking Please respect our residents who live near the school. Please do not block any of the resident driveways as you pick up or drop off your children. Parking is limited near the school.
- 8. Skating Rink Parking Please use caution as you are backing in or out, as many of our walkers are short and may not be easily seen.
- 9. Staff Parking Lot Please do NOT pick up or drop off in the staff parking lot.

Thank you for respecting our drop off and pick up times. We are outside until 3:15pm, so you are free to pick up your child closer to 3:15pm if that works, as there are significantly less vehicles at this time.
