Track and Field

Grade 4-6 Track and Field Day is on Monday, May 26. This will be an all-day event held outdoors.

To ensure your child has a safe and enjoyable day, please make sure they are dressed appropriately for the weather. We recommend hats, sunscreen, athletic clothing, and a sweater if it's cold. It is important that they wear proper footwear, such as running shoes. Please note that socks, bare feet, sandals, or spiked shoes will not be allowed.

Students should bring a bagged lunch and a water bottle to stay hydrated throughout the day. Please remind your child that water guns are not permitted during the event. There will be a concession stand with small items available for purchase (cash sales only) - For students in grades 4-6. Proceeds will go towards new sport uniforms. Below are the prices.

- Chips: \$1.00
- Gatorade (Zero g of sugar thirst quencher): \$2.00
- Hot Rods: \$1.00

The School Council has purchased freezies for all participating students which they will get to enjoy at the end of the track meet.

In the event of inclement weather, the event will only be canceled if student safety is at risk. Should this happen, the Track and Field Day will be rescheduled for May 30.

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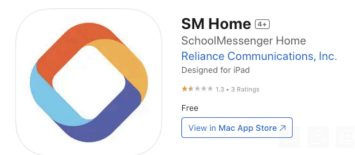
a moment to check the Lost and Found area. Unclaimed items will be donated at the end of the year.

Reporting Absences

The school division has moved to SafeArrival, an absence management system that improves student safety and makes it easy for you to let the school know about your child's absence.

You are asked to report your child's absence in advance whenever possible, here is one convenient way to do so:

- Get the SM Home app from the Apple App Store or the Google Play Store (search for SM Home or visit <https://home.schoolmessenger.ca/> and using one of the linked app download buttons)



- Tap Sign Up to create your account (If you previously used the blue SMap you can sign in with the same credentials.)
- If signing up for the first time there will be an email verification step. Please use your email address that is already on file with the school.
- Select Attendance from the menu, and then select Report an Absence
